Winter sightings (2014/2015)

4th February 2015 (Jean King)

Haywards Heath, West Sussex

I first saw it on the 4th February, when it was feeding on the ground. I had put out dried mealworms and suet pellets.

It was alone and I have not seen it in the company of any others. It has appeared in my garden every day since then at various times, but it seems to stay in the vicinity.

I saw it again earlier today (11th Feb) so it has been in the area for at least a week. It has not seemed particularly nervous of other birds, but is obviously wary.

I did think that for a migrant it has arrived extremely early, but I didn't think it might have overwintered somewhere.

We have consulted a few colleagues and we are all convinced that your bird is a leucistic blackbird, although probably THE most ouzel-like such leucistic blackbird we've seen, if that's any consolation. Our reasoning is as follows:

The white gorget goes too high up the throat

The overall jizz (shape) of the bird is more-blackbird-like, ie chunkier, though ouzels can look chunky when fluffed in winter!

The bird appears too uniform and deep black for an ouzel.

A very interesting bird, though, and would love to see a clearer picture of it. Thanks again for your report. Cheers,

An update from Fiona Freshney: A very useful record you forwarded to us a few days ago. To our knowledge there has been no breeding there since 1979. The female is also a second year bird we ringed in 2012 who failed to produce anything last year so we have a little story for her emerging. In fact I found the birds on the river a good 1.5km away from his grid reference. I did check the area he had referenced which had some moderately suitable habitat but it would be useful to know whether it was a rough grid reference or very accurate. Had the male of the pair I found been where he suggested on the 6th I wonder what he was doing when his female was sitting on young chicks 1.5km away? Just be good to clarify to decide whether it is worth another look near the Vitifer mine leat or not.

A single male Ring Ouzel was in my rural garden in inland Northumberland this morning, hopping around the lawn searching for insects. I have lived here for 19 years, am a regular bird watcher and have never seen one before.

I did the "late" survey on 2nd June - & noted both male & female RO on the same site. While watching across the burn valley a Merlin flew across - prompting the male RO to fly out in an exaggerated display - after a brief encounter the Merlin landed higher up the valley & the RO flew off.

On my return journey to the car I was surprised to find a second male RO about 1km lower down the track from the first pair - initially on an old stone wall - it then flew round the old dykes on an abandoned settlement & disappeared

18th April 2014

Cwmystwyth, Ceredigion (Steve Neville)

Male ring ouzel, spotted at approximately 7.30 a.m. on Friday, 18th April, 2014 at end of our garden. Address: Pant yr Odyn, Cwmystwyth, Ceredigion. Bird appeared healthy.

17th April 2014

Runham, Norfolk (Sharon Jordan)
